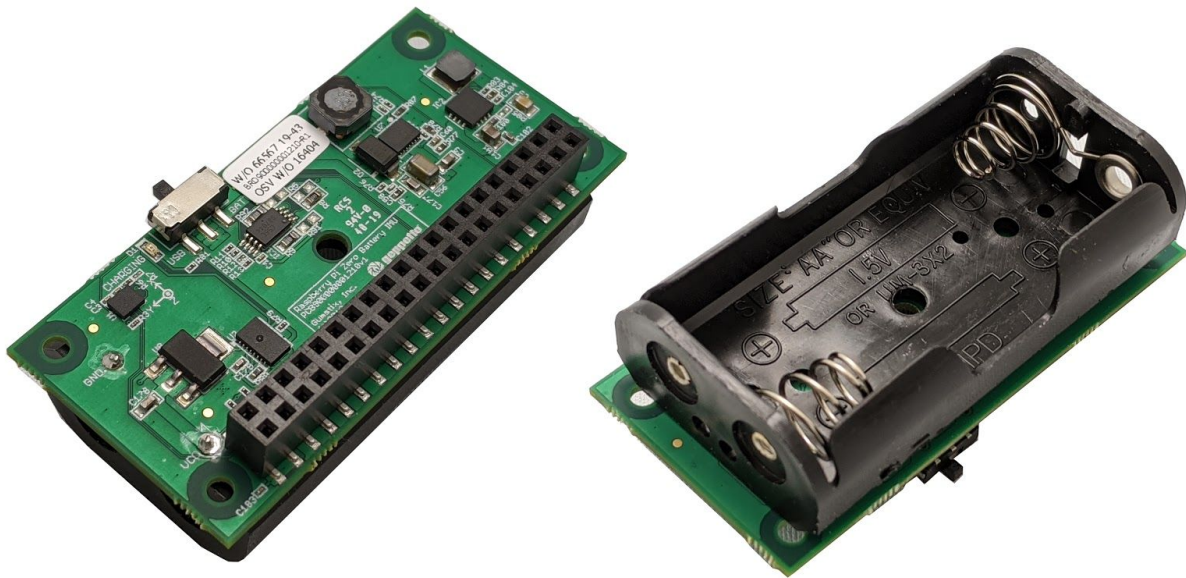




BATTERY POWERED RASPBERRY PI ZERO

With the onboard Bosch BMI160 3-axis accelerometer and 3-axis gyroscope you can easily track motion. Add a camera to enable totally wireless video streaming.

The Gumstix Battery IMU board can also be connected to support a selection of other devices for wireless support. As shown, it is designed to attach to the top of the Pi Zero board.
